The Social Worker's focus is on the family. They work with other home health staff to make sure that the patient and family needs and concerns are addressed so that the child's ongoing health care needs are met. Social Workers have specialized training to assist families in times of physical, emotional, and financial stress. They are well informed about available resources in the community so they can support families in need.

Summary of the Social Worker's Role:

Meet the family to determine if there are resources available to them, offer emotional support, and problem solving strategies.
