Cook Children's Expands with New Pediatric Hospital in Prosper *Primary and urgent care expected to open in Fall 2019*

Prosper, TX (April 25, 2019) – Cook Children's Health Care System, which has a long history of caring for children in North Texas and beyond, is announcing plans to build a new children's hospital in east Denton County in the Town of Prosper.

Cook Children's Medical Center North will be located on Cook Children's North Campus, a 23-acre site at Windsong Parkway and Highway 380. Phase I is already underway and includes primary and urgent care services that will open in the fall of 2019. An outpatient surgery center and a comprehensive outpatient specialty center, including imaging and lab services, will open in the spring of 2020. The new inpatient pediatric hospital consisting of a pediatric intensive care unit, emergency department, operating rooms and medical/surgical unit is scheduled to open in 2022.

As one of the largest freestanding pediatric health care systems in the country, Cook Children's currently operates a number of primary care offices in eastern Denton County and Prosper. The location of the new hospital was specifically chosen to address the emergent need for pediatric health care services in this fast-growing area.

"With more than one million patient encounters each year, Cook Children's is proud of its far-reaching reputation that attracts patients and families from all over the world," said Mr. Rick Merrill, President and CEO of Cook Children's Health Care System. "Our full intent is to offer leading edge technology and services that when combined with our integrated delivery model brings an outstanding patient and family experience."
