

Acceptable masks to wear when visiting Cook Children's locations

All patients and visitors must wear a mask while on any Cook Children's property. **Important:** masks are required for anyone over the age of 2. If needed, Cook Children's will supply a mask in order to keep the appointment from being rescheduled.



Acceptable masks

Homemade cloth masks

(for visitors)



Surgical/procedural masks (tie or ear loop)



Dust masks



N95 masks without vents



Face shields

If a face shield is worn by a family member/visitor, a cloth or surgical mask must ALSO be worn.



✓ If a parent/visitor arrives with a vented mask, they will be given a surgical mask to wear over it. Any type of cloth face covering is acceptable for families/visitors at any of our locations.

We do not recommend wearing a vented mask because they are not as safe.

While not encouraged, a vented mask may be worn by a parent/visitor IF it is covered at all times with a surgical mask. If a parent/visitor has a vented mask, a surgical mask will be provided by Cook Children's staff to wear over the vented mask.
